

Ecko is rated OFA Good for hips and Normal for elbows. Her CERF is clear and current, and she is OptiGen Normal (PRA clear), GM-1 Normal, and Cardio Normal 1-1. Ecko carries the gene for improper coat.

The sire we have chosen for our Spring 2012 litter is “Maquah”, an Italian import more formally known as Int’l/Am. CH Ursodomar Do Lusidias RN WWD. He is a 7-year old brown wavy standing about 20-inches tall and weighing around 53 pounds. Maquah has a gorgeous coat, which has kept its dark color as he has aged. He has a robust, muscular build with an impressive head. He is an athletic dog with high working drive and stamina, both in & out of the water. We love his temperament: confident, spirited, playful and loving. Maquah has sired several litters previously and has passed many of his finer qualities on to his offspring.



Maquah is rated OFA Fair for hips. His CERF is clear and current, and he is OptiGen A1 (PRA clear), GM-1 Normal, and Cardio Normal 1-1. He does not carry the gene for improper coat.
